It is a three-stream (Arts, Science & Commerce) co-educational institution affiliated to Dibrugarh University, having both morning and day shifts. ABOUT THE SEMINAR

India's higher education is the third largest in the world only next to United States and China. Higher Education system in India has expanded at a rapid pace with nearly 20000 colleges and more than 8 million students included in a decade from 2000-01 to 2010-11 as per the National Census report 2011. With more student enrolment in Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs), which of course is a positive sign,

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the teacher-student ratio may become unrealistic leading to compromise in quality of higher education. Indian higher education is in need of radical reforms which would ensure providing quality education and also embracing increased number of students. Digital initiatives in HEIs could serve this purpose.

Introduction of technology in HEIs is undoubtedly happening but at a slow pace and only in certain places. This could be due to lack of proper awareness about the benefits and scope of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in higher education or perhaps the teachers and the authority are sceptical regarding the role of technology as they feel that it might replace the teacher altogether.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

For abstract :

Title of the paper, author(s) name, key words, with uniqueness of the research work, major findings within 200 words.

For full paper :

Length: Within 5000 words (including abstract, reference and appendix) in Times New Roman font with size 12. The full paper should contain introduction, objectives, data base, methodology, results and discussion and conclusion and policy framework.

Title page: Article title, author(s) name with affiliation and email, corresponding author's address, contact number and email id should be included.

Main Text: Should be readable and technical details should be provided in appendix.

Footnotes: Should be used as sparingly as possible and must be identified in the text by consecutive numbers placed as superscript.

Tables and Figures: Should be numbered consecutively. Tables should be titled at top and figures captioned below.

Colour code: The entire text and tables/figures should be in black colour.

Reference: Please follow APA citation style.

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
